Ray Nugent reported there are an excessive amount of accidents happening at Rt. 52 and Cedar. Ray has been in contact with IDOT and Will County DOT to get more signage going Northbound. In fact, Ray stated there was a bad accident just last week that would have seriously injured or killed Township workers if they had been in the yard at that moment in time. Bridge cleaning will be taking place on Walsh Road. There is too much silt on the West side. This is only a quick fix and a temporary band aid since there is no bridge fund. Another bridge that will be cleaned is Cedar and County Line. This will take approximately 40K from the Road District Account. Ray will be seeking board approval to enforce the frost ordinance limiting 5 tons for the winter. This will save wear and tear on the roads. He may also be contemplating rewriting and tweaking the ordinance to restrict garbage trucks and school buses, but this will need serious thought before a decision can be made.
